SUBJECT LTP project update

1 Purpose of Report

The purpose of this report is to provide an update on the progress of the 2015 LTP project.

2 Project progress

At the time of writing this report there were 288 days before the 2015 Long Term Plan is adopted. That puts us very near the half way stage for what is typically around the country an 18 month project. Compared to previous long term plan projects we have a later timetable and therefore will be running our public consultation in March/April 2015 (coinciding with most other councils). The attached project status report explains our progress to date against each of the sub-projects.

3 Key dates ahead

Council workshops for further development of the Long Term Plan have been scheduled for the remainder of the year. An outline of the topics for each of the workshops is listed below. We are considering ways to run the joint December budget workshop so that Community Boards can individually consider their priorities should the budget result require prioritisation.

4 Changes from LGA Amendment

The Long Term Plan process was subject to a number of changes implemented through the Local Government Amendment Act 2013. The two significant changes affecting the Long Term Plan process are the inclusion in the Long Term Plan of a 30 year infrastructure strategy and changes to how we publicly consult on the plan. A brief summary of the changes in the Amendment Act that relate to the long term plan process are below:
