

Adoption of Parking Control Bylaw 2014

SUBJECT **Adoption of Parking Control Bylaw 2014**

1 Purpose of Report

To present the revised draft Parking Control Bylaw 2014 to Council for adoption. The revised draft bylaw reflects resolutions made during deliberations by the Judicial Committee.

The Judicial Committee has delegation for development and review of Council's regulatory policies and district bylaws but cannot adopt a bylaw, which must be by Council resolution.

2 Background

The Council consulted on its proposed draft Parking Control Bylaw 2014 using the special consultative procedure. A hearing and deliberations were held on 17 October 2014 with the Judicial Committee.

3 Issue

The draft bylaw has been revised to reflect resolutions made during deliberations and is now presented for adoption - provided as **Attachment A**.

4 Discussion

Several fairly minor changes have been made to the proposed draft bylaw in response to submissions. On adoption of the revised bylaw staff will undertake signage and marking work required to reflect changes.

In submissions issues were raised with parking availability on Mackay Street and Mary Street in Thames. The Judicial Committee deliberated and determined to make no changes to the proposed draft bylaw at this time, but to refer the matter to the Thames Community Board for recommendation. If changes to the local parking controls are considered necessary then amendments are able to be made to the bylaw schedule by Council resolution. An appropriate report has been prepared for the next Thames Community Board meeting.

5 Suggested Resolution(s)

That the Thames-Coromandel District Council:

1. Receives the Adoption of Parking Control Bylaw report, dated 28 October 2014.
2. Adopts the Parking Control Bylaw 2014 in the form attached to the report.
3. Resolves that at 12 midnight on 12 December 2014 the current Parking Control Bylaw is revoked and the new Parking Control Bylaw 2014 comes into force.
