F&B were keen to have a boardwalk however at \$750-\$1000 per metre this would likely be cost prohibitive. The long term likelihood of a Long Bay walkway was discussed and whether it was feasible to construct the walkway through the wetland as there appeared to be obstacles to putting a path in either side of the road. Jim Dahm Coastal Scientist is looking into whether WRC could provide fill from drainage works in the CMA to form a stable base for a walkway.
