

**2013/14 Draft Annual Plan Submission - Mercury Bay Community Board**

**5 April 2013**

**Hot Water Beach Parking Management Project - Page 27 and 28**

A pay and display parking system for Hot Water Beach main carpark has been added as a project in the Mercury Bay area.

**Issue:** The Board supports the Council decision for the revenue generated by the fees from pay and display, to establish a fund for local amenities within the area.

**Decision Sought:** The Board supports the project as per its Community Board Plan.

The Board submits that the following Fees and Charges be included in the 2013/14 Annual Plan:

- Private vehicle parking rate per hour - \$2 per hour.
- Private vehicle daily rate (up to 8 hours) - \$15-.00
- Breach of parking area time limits or non-payment infringement fee - \$40
- That ratepayers in the wider Mercury Bay Community Board area will be exempt from parking charges at Hot Water Beach.
- That staff establish an remaining infringement fees as needed.

The Board also requests that the a special fund is set up to hold monies collected from parking fees, with rules around what the funds are to be used for. The Board requests that the following principles be applied to the fund:

- The use of the fund is to be determined by the Mercury Bay Community Board and that the fund be primarily for the maintenance and development of infrastructure in the wider Mercury Bay area that is impacted on by tourism/vistors with one priority being the new toilet block at Hot Water Beach.
