



## 9 Conclusion

This report has been prepared to accompany the application by Spark to establish, operate and maintain a telecommunication facility at 436 Onemana Drive. The facility is necessary to service to the Onemana community.

The proposal has been assessed against and complies with the relevant regulations under the NES and is confirmed as a Permitted Activity. Resource consent is required under the Thames Coromandel District Plan as a Non – Complying Activity.

Based on the assessments presented in the report, it is considered that the proposal adequately addresses the matters set out in Section 104 of the RMA that are relevant to the granting of consent to the application. Furthermore, for the reasons outlined in the Assessment of Environmental Effects in Section 7 of this report, the actual and potential effects of the proposed facilities are considered to be at levels that are appropriate in the context of the receiving environment. It follows that the proposal is considered to be in accordance with the relevant objectives and policies of the operative District Plan, which are directed at providing for utilities in a manner that respects the character and amenity values of the receiving environment.

On this basis, it is considered that the proposal adequately addresses the matters outlined in Sections 104 and 104A of the RMA, and there are no impediments to the granting of the resource consent sought on a non-notified basis.
