1 Purpose of Report

This report seeks an appointment by the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board to the Coromandel Arts and Creative Industries Advisory Board.

2 Background

On 29 June 2016 Council resolved to endorse the Coromandel Arts and Creative Industries Strategy and to establish the Coromandel Arts and Creative Industries Advisory Board. The strategy had been developed over the preceding year, driven predominantly by the various arts communities and tangata whenua around the peninsula with council staff playing a role in facilitation and creation of the final strategy. Council is now a partner to this strategy, with the last Council intending that community boards hold the primary responsibility of engaging with tangata whenua and the arts communities in their respective areas to develop agreed action plans and to undertake work on these action plans across a set timeframe.

The structure for the advisory board provides for the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board to make one appointment from nominees within the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board area who have completed an expression of interest application. The South East Coromandel Arts Council was also able to make an appointment to the advisory board however they have not been able to provide a representative for this area.

There has recently been an expression of interest for the remaining role for Tairua-Pauanui area on the Board by Emma Darragh which the South East Coromandel Arts Council had been unable to fill.

3 Discussion

The expression of interest for the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board area from Emma Darragh has been included as **(Attachment A)**. Staff recommend the appointment of Emma Darragh to the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board area role.

4 Suggested Resolution(s)

That the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board:

1. Receives the 'Appointment to the Coromandel Arts and Creative Industries Advisory Board' report dated 22 March 2017
2. Appoint Emma Darragh to the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board area position on the Coromandel Arts and Creative Industries Advisory Board for the term of three years.
