SUBJECT	Proposed Road Names - Azimuth Subdivision, Tairua

1 Purpose of report

To consider an application for the naming of three roads for a new subdivision within the Tairua-Pauanui Ward.

2 Background

These roads would service the new development known as Azimuth Estate off 297 Main Road , SH25 Tairua. The development is being created in stages but approval is being sort for all new roads now in anticipation. The developer has put forward three names which are listed below along with a brief reason and/or meaning:

- **Azimuth Road** - Name of subdivision and means 'The **azimuth** is the angle between a celestial body (sun, moon) and the North'
- **Mason Ridge** - developers name
- **Bill Brewster Lane** - one of the original developers of Paku

3 Issue

All the roads within the District, whether private or Council owned require an approved road name.

4 Discussion

All proposed names put forward meet AS/NZ4819:2011 standards however the road type **RIDGE** is not a valid NZ road type option according to this standard, so suggest **RISE** as the alternative, no similar names exist currently within the TCDC roads index.

No other consultation has been completed or deemed required.

5 Suggested resolution(s)

That the Tairua-Pauanui Community Board:

1. Receives the 'Proposed Road Names - Azimuth Subdivision, Tairua' report, dated 2 August 2017
2. Recommends that Council approve the road names **Azimuth Road**, **Mason Rise** and **Bill Brewster Lane** for the Azimuth Estate development in Tairua.
