OR ACCESS TO THE PARK

THE PLASTIC FENCE AND A VERY LARGE STAGE
HAS REMAINED IN ^{PLACE} BEFORE AND AFTER THE
TWO CONCERTS DENYING RESIDENTS ANY ACCESS OVER
THE LARGER PART OF WILLIAMSON PARK.

SOLD RIGHT IN THE MIDDLE OF AN ALCOHOL BAN
AREA. AS HAS BEEN DEMONSTRATED THIS HAS NOT

HORSE AROUND THE SURROUNDING RESIDENTIAL AREA
